A New American Non-sectarian Secret Society, Home Office, Condon, Oregon

The name of the Society is **UNITED MINUTE MEN OF THE CONSTITUTION**. Not organized for profit.

Some of the objects and purposes of the Society are as follows:

- 1—To inculcate and instill into the minds and hearts of its members and the citizens of our country, a clearer and higher regard for the Constitution of the United States, and the laws of our country;
- 2—to inculcate and instill into the minds and hearts of its members, and the citizens of our country, patriotism, love of country, reverence for law and order, performance of civic duty, and undivided allegiance to duly constituted public authority;
- 3—To inculcate and instill into the minds and hearts of its members and the citizens of our country that our government is one of the laws, not men;
- 4—To inculcate and instill into the minds and hearts of its members, and the citizens of our country that there should be absolute religious equality among all religious believers and among all religions.

The membership is confined to people of the white race, who are over 21 years of age, and such as have not been convicted of any felony or any crime involving moral turpitude. It excludes from its membership all persons belonging to any organization using or authorizing any of its members to use gowns and masks in public parades so their identity may be concealed.

It invites new members to its organization who can and will subscribe to the above objects and who will take the obligation of the society, and in good faith practice the things enumerated in their public and private lives. Names of the members are kept secret from those not members of this society.

Any towns in Oregon, or elsewhere, desiring to affiliate with this organization, may acquire a charter from this society upon proper application; and this society will render such assistance as will be helpful to towns having a peculiar problem to solve which affects their business, religion and welfare through organizations which boycott or shun all people not identified with its organization.
