A spectacular test of one of the new safety devices was made in Cal-Ifornia on June 20, and is described in the August Popular Mechanics Magazine. A young woman jumped from a aeroplane at a height of more than 1,000 ft. and landed safely on earth without the slightest injury. The apparatus she used is kown as a 'safety pack'. It is a parachute of Drs. 


