Percheron Prize Winners Raised in Northwest.

In the sturdy Percheron horses pictured above may be seen the qualities which are establishing their popularity with the farmer. Massive but not awkward strength is shown in every line. These horses, while costing much more than those of common breed, often prove an economy. When there is heavy work to be done, a Percheron horse is nearly as efficient as two ordinary beasts, while his upkeep is not much more than the cost of one. In the illustration the animals are grouped to show the remarkable development in muscular power which gives these animals their value.
