IGNITION—Simms type, high-tension magneto.

CLUTCH—Cone type in flywheel, motobestos lined.

TRANSMISSION—Selective sliding gear type,

three speeds forward and one reverse.

CONTROL—Left side drive, center control, foot accelerator. 16 in. hand wheel.

WHEEL BASE—103 in.

TIRES—30 x 3 1/2 in., front and rear. Famous make of Anti-Skid tires on rear.
