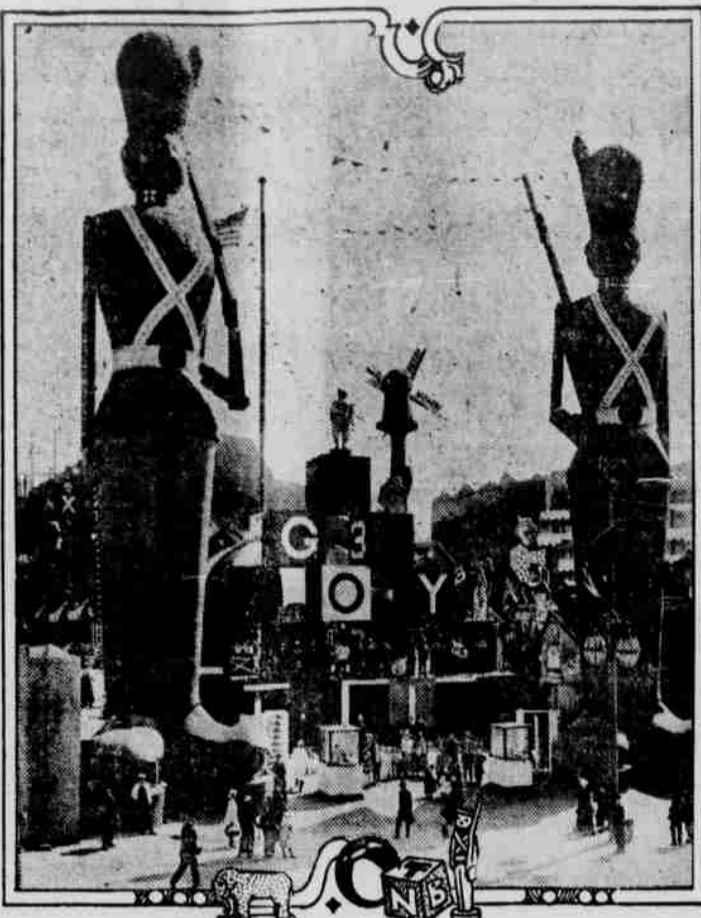

### SCHOOL NOTES.

By Supt. S. E. Notson.

Blanks have been sent to the several school clerks upon which they will make their annual reports. I find that in some districts a copy of this report is not filled out in the clerk's record book. A copy should always be filled out in the record book in the place provided for it.

The balance on hand at the last annual meeting, the amount of the apportionment made by the county superintendent, and a few other items have been filled in on the blanks. This will save the clerks some time. These figures must not be changed. If your books do not show the same facts, write to the superintendent at once.

The law requires the report of the clerk to be approved at the annual meeting; the report should be carefully made out before that meeting. The board should examine the books to see that the accounts are correct and agree with the report. The report should be sent in within five days. This is very important this year. Owing to the change in the date of the teachers' examination for June the work in the offices of the county superintendents and the State Superintendent will be greatly congested during the month of July, hence it is important that the reports be made on time. Unless they come in promptly, your district may lose its apportionment, which is something we should all regret.

It is not advisable for districts to vote a tax at the annual meeting this year. The change in the law is such that it will be much better to hold a special meeting after the tax roll is completed. This will be an inconvenience for several districts, but it is the safe plan.

Many inquiries have come in in regard to the date of the annual meeting. The date has not been changed except for districts having a popula-

tion of over 20,000.

I would suggest again that the rural districts hold a sort of picnic or basket dinner on the day of the annual meeting. The people can then take up the matters necessary to make the school a standard school. If this is done, no doubt quite a number of the schools which have not reached the standard mark this year will be able to do so next year. I would especially urge that the term be made not less than eight months.

## BIG SHEEP SHIPMENT TO CHICAGO

**D. B. Zimmerman Takes Big Shipment From Local Yards to Chicago.**

Thirty-three carloads of sheep were shipped out of the Heppner yards within the past week. Of this shipment, 11 cars went to Omaha, and 22 cars to Chicago. D. B. Zimmerman had charge of the shipment which went to the windy city. Joe Hughes of Heppner and Glenn Hadley of Hardman accompanied the sheep as far as McIntosh, S. D.

James R. Hooper, Jr., representing the Boston wool firm of Crimmins & Pierce, arrived in Heppner Friday evening from Pendleton to look over the present wool situation. Mr. Hooper was very much pleased with the outlook and will return to Heppner next week to attend the wool sales.

Arch Cox, who runs sheep on the Silas Wright place on Rhea creek, last week disposed of his wool, receiving 20 cents for his coarse and 18 cents for his fine wool.
