Junction public schools add industrial course.

Sherwood has completed two fine new business blocks.

There is an opening for a state bank at Tigardville.

Astoria city tax for 1916 to be 1.2 mills less than for 1915.

Hood River is harvesting the second crop of strawberries.

Oregon's freak Sunday law is to be construed to stop baseball.

The new Motor Vehicle Law will produce \$400,000 revenue.

Municipal theaters are advocated by Prof. Sowers of U. of O.

Monument and Clatsop Plains planning union high schools.

Hon. S. L. Moorhead of Junction has bought the St. Helens Mist.

Clatsop Plains cranberry industry is yielding 50 barrels to acre.

The Weinhard Brewing Co., Portland, will manufacture near-beer.

Portland will rebuild Tanner Creek trunk sewer, to cost \$50,000.

Lane county citizens are asking 30 per cent reduction in valuations.

M. H. Squires plans \$40,000 fireworks factory to be located at Gresham.

Rail laying on the Willamette-Pacific has begun south of St. Lawrence.

Work is to start again on the Sutherlin, Coos Bay and Eastern railroads.

A. G. Bauer and E. C. Conley have bought the Hughes furniture store at Eugene.

Yaquina Harbor part districts will defray half expense of proposed improvement.

J. C. Butcher is establishing a \$10,000 arsenate of lead spray plant at Hood River.

A. R. Badger of St. Helens, has order for 400 incubators from a catalogue house.

C. E. Taylor has bought Stayton Electric Light plant and will make improvements.

Prineville Journal has it that A. R. Rogers Co. will build mill and railroad to their timber holdings.

Coast Culvert & Flume Co., Kenton, is building a 40x60 foot two-story addition to factory.

The S. P. Co. is negotiating for the purchase of 80 acres additional ground at Springfield for car shop purposes. It has already purchased 245 acres.

Clyde C. Dawson, representative of Colorado Governor, in his address before the water power conference at Portland, put the whole problem in a nutshell in the following paragraph: "The completely rounded scheme which looks to the control of our resources on the public domain would lead to the substitution of a servile tenantry for an independent citizenship of owners, and would leave the destiny of our future growth and development to the arbitrary control of ever-changing officials in the far-distant city of Washington."

This performance was an appropriate close to a record of mismanagement that is unparalleled in the history of our government.

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DELAYED LEGISLATION CAUSES LARGE WASTE

Washington, Sept. 29.—Vast governmental operations involving the expenditure of more than one hundred million dollars were practically paralyzed for over a month last year by failure of the Democratic Congress to properly enact necessary legislation.

The "tie-up" was paramount to a strike with hundreds of thousands of men idle, according to government officials charged with expenditure of the funds controlled by the legislation. The amount was contained in what is popularly termed the "sundry civil" bill. In order to carry out the plans on which it was based, the bill had to be passed by June 30. It did not pass until more than a month later. For the intervening time none of the future work contemplated in the legislation could be started.

It would take hundreds of pages to describe the disastrous results of this heedless delay. Only a mere hint can be given of the activities the "sundry civil" bill provided for. It is one of the largest supply bills Congress handles, and included nearly four million dollars for improvements and maintenance of soldiers' homes; two and a half millions for the protection of public health; seven millions and more for keeping up life saving stations and light houses; over one million for fortifications on the Panama Canal; over three and a half millions to enable the Interstate Commerce Commission to continue the physical valuation of railroads and other important activities; more than thirteen millions for building quarantine stations, hospitals and other public buildings theretofore authorized; and numerous other less striking features.

"It is imperative that funds for purposes like this shall be made available with the beginning of the fiscal year," said a government official in discussing this subject. "Every day's delay after that is nearly a total loss. Funds really ought to be ready by May 1 of each year; but to fail to provide them by July 1, and have to resort to resolutions continuing old appropriations, as Congress was forced to do in this instance is sheer waste."

"From ten to fifteen per cent of the amount of an appropriation is a total loss if it is not passed before July 1. If the money wasted in delayed appropriations during the last four years could be made available now, we would not need to be devising ways and means to replenish the treasury. The waste would probably more than cover the estimated deficit."

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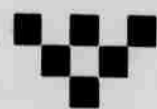
