## INDUSTRIAL ITEMS OF GENERAL INTEREST

Baker is to get a modern dairy plant.

Roseburg is planning \$75,000 high school.

Donald is campaigning for a cheese factory.

North Powder wants to build a new school house.

Ashland—\$15,000 is to be spent remodeling hotel Oregon.

Monmouth is to get a \$5000 co-operative creamery plant.

Yoncola votes April 17 on \$20,000 bonds for waterworks.

The quick-silver mine near London is to resume operations.

Marshfield—Sawmill at Isthmus Inlet to be operated this month.

Enterprise—Roger Bros. will erect brick, stone or concrete garage.

Portland is to have a new vaudeville theatre to cost \$125,000.

Dallas Commercial Club is boosting a tank factory at that place.

The Christian church of Springfield is planning a \$1000 addition.

The Pacific Coast Steel Co. plans to erect a \$500,000 plant in Portland.

Eugene—Business men are promoting enlarged fire brick factory.

Corvallis has granted the Southern Pacific a franchise upon its own terms.

Ontario—A district is to be formed to develop Warm Springs irrigation project.

The Spaulding Logging Co. will cut 55,000,000 feet of logs back of Corvallis.

Marshfield—Wooden ware factory to make a carload daily seeking location here.

The Portland Brewing Co. has resumed operations and will make non-alcoholic beer.

Annually enough water goes to waste in Umatilla county to irrigate 100,000 acres of land.

McMinnville—County clerk will sell \$7000 bonds to build bridge across Willamette slough.

Plans are on foot to irrigate 100,000 acres of Little and Big Agency plains in Jefferson and Crook counties.

Grants Pass—The Dyer Company, of Cleveland, O., have the contract for erecting \$600,000 sugar factory here.

Gresham—Before taking advantage of the Union high school gymnasium students must procure a physician's certificate as to physical condition.

Independence—Wm. Riddell hired a man to catch gophers on his farm. Result: 3800 in one year at 25 cents each, or nearly a thousand dollars from this crop.

New industries are coming to the state, and in many towns the erection of new buildings and new plants have been announced. Everywhere in the state are the signs of steady, consistent and encouraging growth.

Prince Superior, the bull purchased by W. O. Minor, the Shorthorn breeder of Heppner, Ore., from the Walter Hill consignment at the Portland Shorthorn sale in December, was bred by Smith & White, successors to N. P. Clark, of Minnesota. He is by the great Ringmaster and his dam Marlon Woodhill, by Nonpariel Marquis, was bred by W. H. Dunwoody, the well known Canadian breeder.

Mr. Minor, who has only recently acquired his Shorthorns and farm back from the man who purchased the place, says he has none in condition yet to sell. But he was fortunate in securing plenty of hay to go through this hard winter and has plenty of feed of all kinds, so he expects to have them in better shape by spring. He is scarcely able to supply the demand, which promises to be still greater. Hugh Neal is now Mr. Minor's herdsman.—Rural Spirit.
