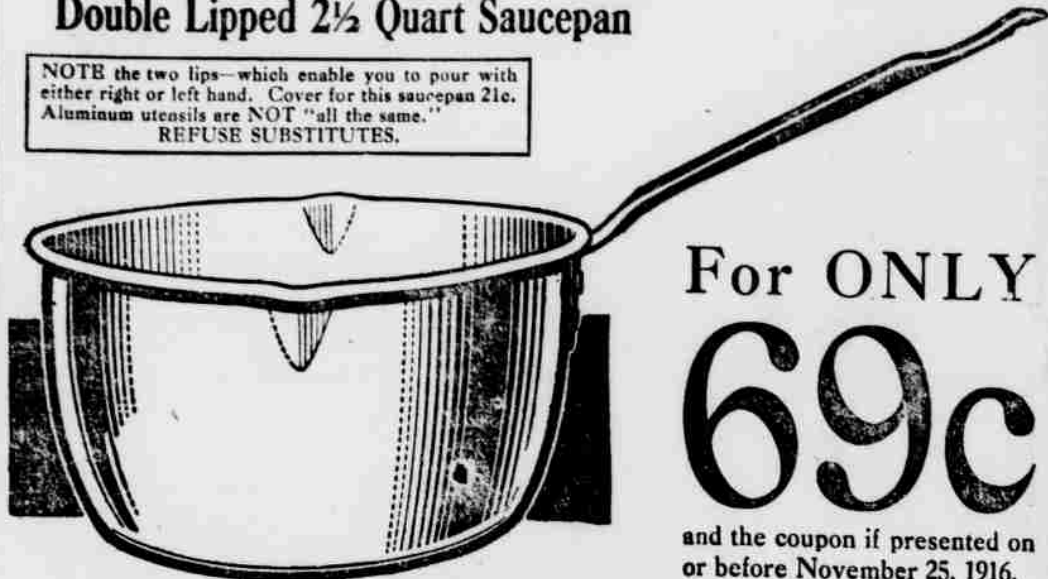

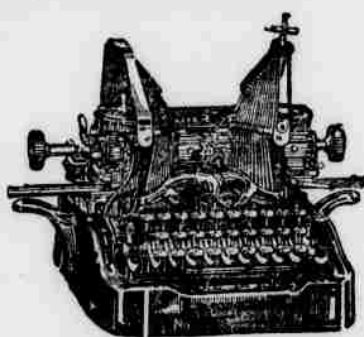

Rock Island clubhouse in Willamette river to be built.

Mill City—Frank Potter will build a shingle mill here.

Henryville—Coal mine here leased and will be operated.

Legislature asked to create office of state fire marshal.

Laneview votes \$20,000 bonds to buy railroad right of way.

Florence—Capital to be enlisted for shipbuilding plant here.

Coos Bay—Three large vessels on ways at North Bend shipyard.

Portland to have another motor car assembling plant on East side.

One of Hill lines adds 5 per cent to all who get under \$200 a month.

Pendleton woolen mills book \$20,000 order for marching uniforms.

Oregon tax limitation law will compel reduction in all departments.

Portland—Monarch sawmill sold million dollar rolling mills planned.

Lincoln county may bridge Yaquina river near the head of the Bay.

Roseburg—The O. C. land grant lands are to be thrown open in 1917.

Grants Pass, Nov 11 celebrated establishment of sugar beet industry.

Dallas J. K. Armsby Co. has million pounds of prunes awaiting shipment.

Portland jitney ordinance requiring franchise, bond and schedule upheld by courts.

Electrification of S. P. line from Whitson to Corvallis to be complete January 1.

Astoria Flouring Mills Co. awards contract for \$30,000 worth of additional machinery.

Klamath Falls votes \$300,000 bonds to aid California, Oregon and Eastern railroad.

Oregon wool has recently sold in Portland for the highest price in history of the state.

Oregon and Washington tide water mills shipped 34,212,787 ft. of lumber during October.

Portland held tax increase down to seven one-hundredths of a mill and cut \$726,000 from budget.

Grants Pass—Improvement company to be incorporated to supply water to land owners in district north or river.

State spending \$70,000 on hydrographic surveys with no capital going into irrigation schemes will probably be stopped.

Eugene—Fresh fish by the carload is being shipped from Umpqua river by way of Willamette-Pacific and Eugene to New York.

Bandon—Old Eagle mine near Bullards changes name to Platnay Ore Mining Co. and output will be increased to 200 tons daily.

Portland—Northwest Steel Co. contemplates adding \$1,000,000 rolling mill to their plant, several hundred additional men would be employed.

Astoria—With 100 acres of cranberry marsh, part of which is now bearing, Clatsop County expects to make a dent in the future cranberry market.

McMinnville—Co-operative cannery and fruit drying plant planned for this locality and Yamhill farmers and business men visit similar plant at Eugene.

St. Johns—Providing for future business, the Standifer-Clarkson Co. is to have four sets of ways at the North Portland harbor plant, located on property adjoining that of the Monarch mill.

Junction City.—Carpenter & Chambers setting up sawmill west of here to cut 60,000 ties as sub contract to the Menefee Co. of Portland who have order from Oregon Electric, North Bank and affiliated lines for 160,000.

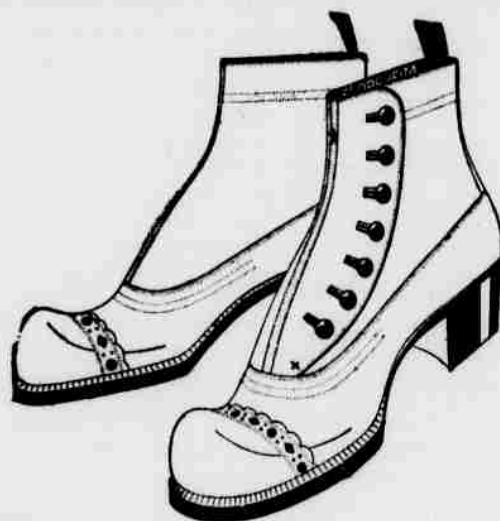
