Reports say Newport will have sardine cannery.
Blachley to erect a large union graded school.
Nyssa will have a flouring mill in the near future.
Burns to Crane railroad to be built by local company.
Portland—Laurelhurst to have \$40,000 club house.

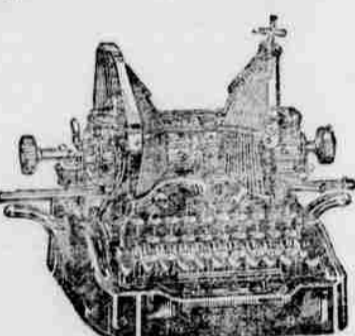
