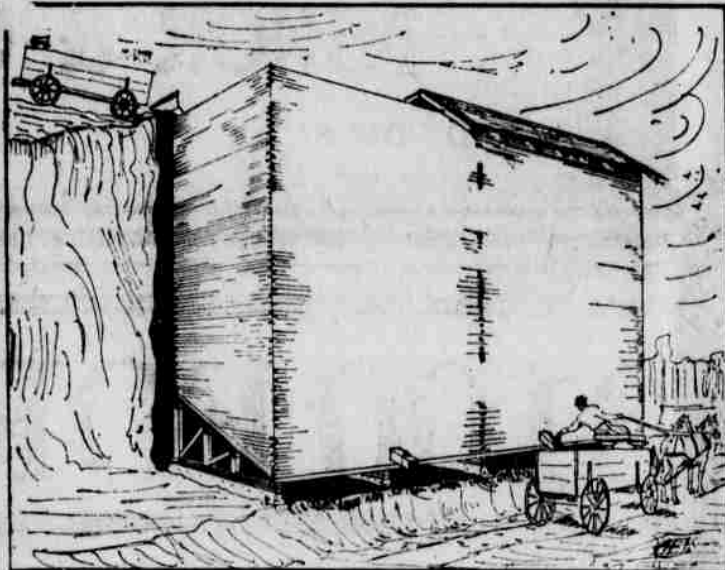
Portland plans new million bushel elevators!

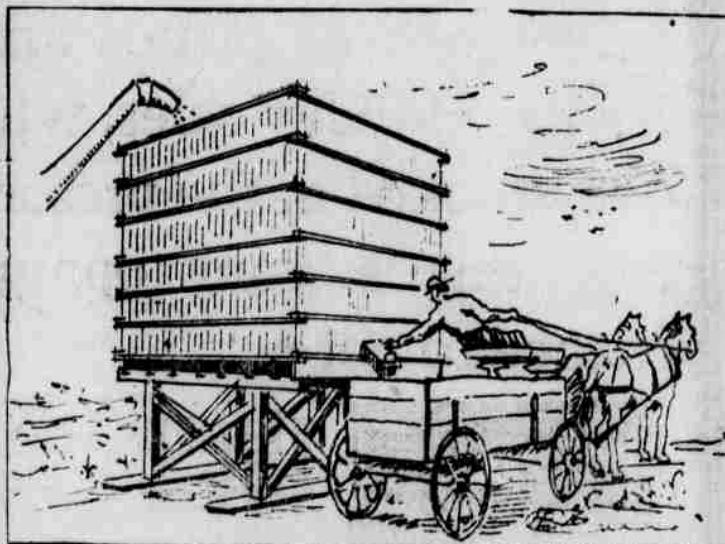

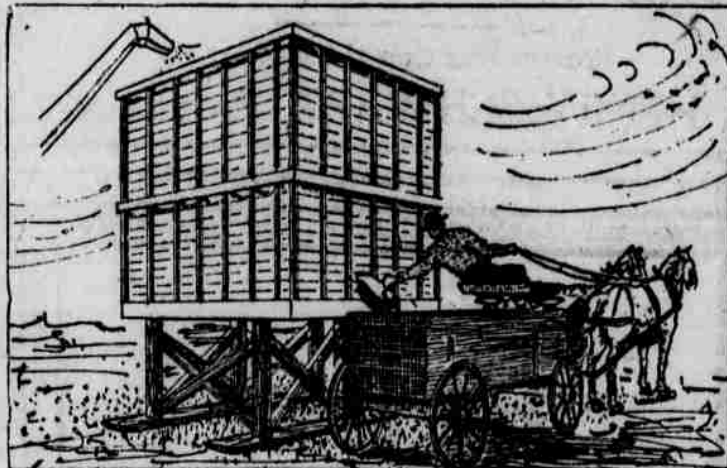
