## RHUBARB IS GOOD FRUIT SUBSTITUTE

It is Easily Grown and Can Be Bought Cheaply on the Market—Has Same General Effect as Oranges

Oregon Agriculture College, Corvallis, Oregon.—The value and the use of rhubarb as a part of the diet are strongly emphasized by domestic science experts. It is pointed out that this fruit is easily raised and can be obtained at a reasonable price on the market, and is therefore within the reach of every family. In general, the effect of the use of rhubarb is the same as that of oranges, except that it contains oxalic acid which makes it unsuitable for people afflicted with gravel. Although it is botanically a vegetable, it is generally used as a "fruit." Rhubarb is especially beneficial in the spring when the system has been nourished on heavier food, and because it becomes available earlier than most other vegetables.

Suggestions are also advanced for the preparation of rhubarb for table use, and several recipes are given, two of which are as follows:

**Rhubarb Pie**  
1 1/2 cups rhubarb stalks cut in 1/2 inch pieces.  
2 cups sugar

3 table spoons cracker crumbs  
Mix sugar, cracker crumbs and egg, add rhubarb and bake in open crust as for custard pie. Make a meringue of the egg whites, cover pie and brown in slow oven.

**Steamed Rhubarb Sauce**  
1 quart rhubarb cut in 1/2 inch pieces.  
2 cups sugar.

Cut off the leaves and the root and wash the stalks, and cut in one half inch lengths. Put the rhubarb into a double boiler, add the sugar, mix well and cover the boiler tight.—Bertha Davis, Instructor in Home Economics at O. A. C.
