HEPPNER SON IS NOW FRISCO POLICE JUDGE

Mayor Will Appoint Former Assistant Secretary to Brady's Place on Bench.

Sylvester J. McAtee, former newspaper man and one time assistant secretary to Mayor Rolph, attorney for the State Bank Superintendent, is to succeed District Attorney-elect Matthew Brady as police judge after January 8, 1920.

Mayor Rolph yesterday announced

he will appoint McAtee when the vacancy on the bench occurs.

In making this selection the mayor paid high tribute to McAtee, reciting his public services with the city as indicative of his ability and character.

McAtee is among the active members of the San Francisco bar, having been admitted in 1915. He has lived in San Francisco since he was 14, having come from Heppner, Ore., his birthplace.

He has been closely identified with Mayor Rolph's activities and has had part in many of the municipal affairs in which the mayor has been particularly interested.

He directly managed the majority and gubernatorial campaigns for Rolph.—San Francisco Examiner.

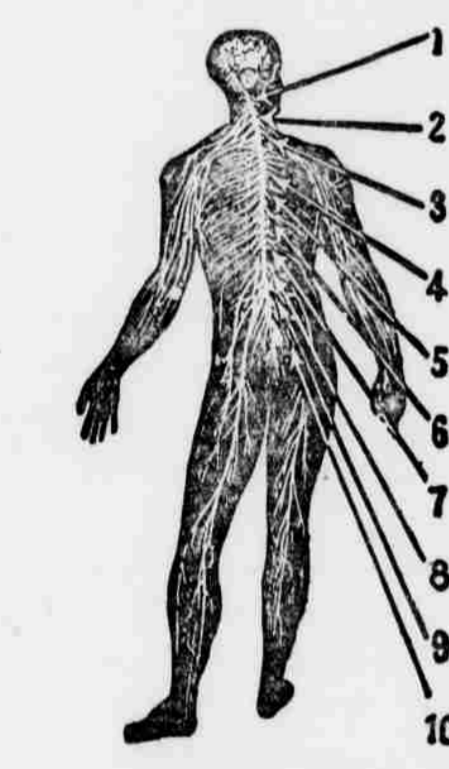

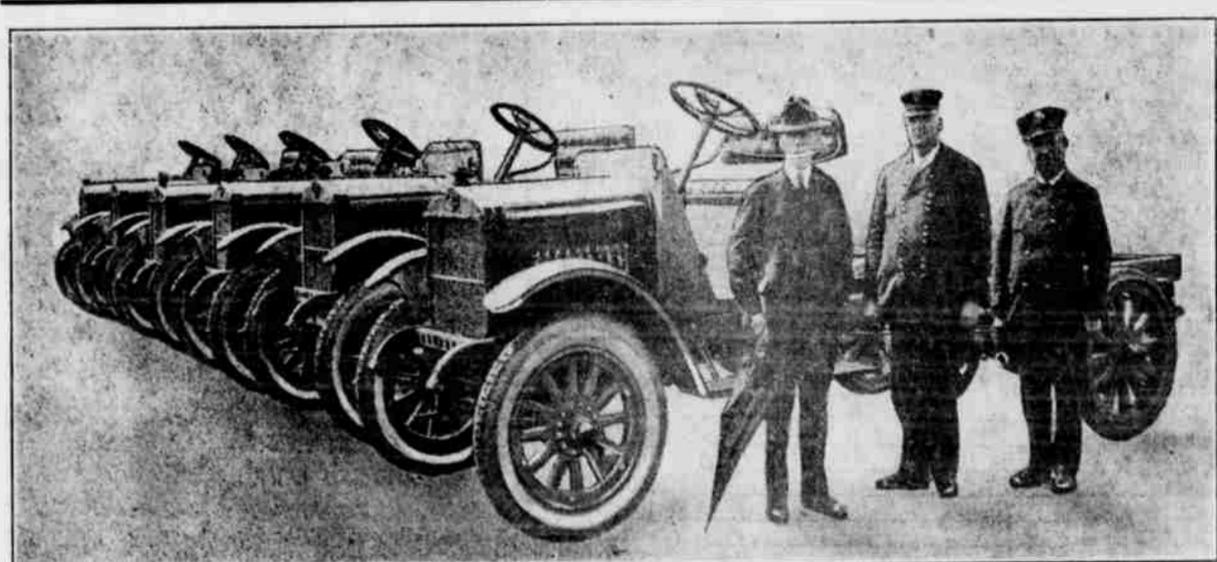
