COUNTY COURT HAS BIG JANUARY SESSION

County Court met in regular session on January 7, 1920 with the following officers present: Hon. Wm. T. Campbell, Judge; E. L. Padberg, commissioner; G. A. Bleakman, commissioner; Geo. McDuffee, sheriff; J. A. Waters, clerk.

When among others the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the Matter of Designating Rhea Creek, a Market Road.

The Court at this time took up the matter of the designation of Rhea Creek from forks of the creek to the concrete bridge at the Mason Ranch, as a Market Road, and after due consideration of the matter it was unanimously agreed by the court that said road be designated as a market road and a Resolution to that effect was spread upon the minutes, a copy of which was sent to the Oregon State Highway Commission.
