 A new speed record for an air trip through the Columbia river gorge was set by Walter E. Lees, pilot for the Oregon, Washington & Idaho Airplane company, when he covered the ninety miles between Portland and The Dalles in eighty-five minutes.
 Lees drove a J-N type Curtis airplane, the first of its kind to land in The Dalles.
 Lees' trip to The Dalles was taken, among other reasons, to investigate the possibility of carrying hay by plane to starving cattle in the hills back of the city. The cattle are said to be without feed, the condition of the roads making it impossible to transport it overland.
 The plan under consideration is to hang bales of hay under the plane and drop them in open spots in the hills in the shape of fodder bombs.

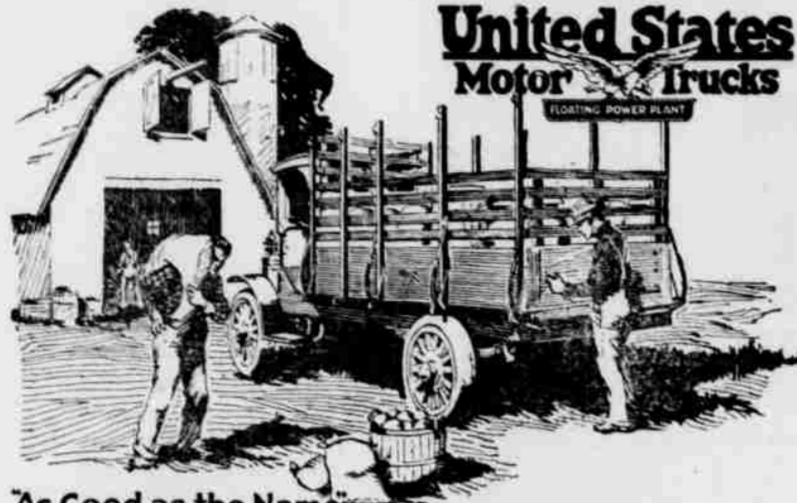

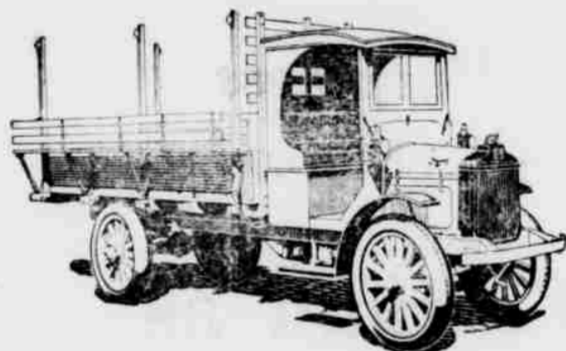
