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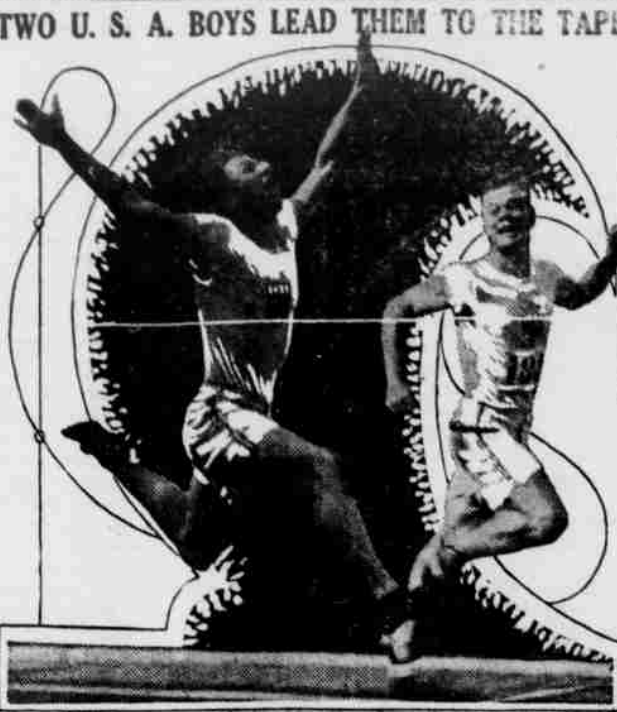

Change Rumored.

It is rumored here that there is to be a change in the Forest Office at John Day. W. W. Cryder, present acting supervisor will be transferred. In justice to Mr. Cryder and to the service this change should be made. Unfortunately Mr. Cryder got mixed up in the plan to change the office from John Day to Burns. The protest which followed cost the users about \$750 and inasmuch as they have been subjected to several of these campaigns it does not set very well with them. Mr. Cryder has had to carry most of the blame for the last fight and it might take several years for him to overcome the prejudice. During this time he would be working to a disadvantage and it would be unfair to him. Mr. Cryder has made good and he can continue to make good and there is no use for him to work on an uphill job. With a fresh start for him and a new man for the users of the Malheur forest the service will get much more satisfactory results. The stockmen of Grant county are interested in forest service, and they welcome the opportunity to work in harmony with it. With this disposition they want to be taken into confidence and considered and consulted. Confidence in the service must be established in order to get harmonious cooperation. September 14 to 17, Tillamook, Tillamook; September 15 to 18 Coos County, Myrtle Point; September 17 to 18, Hood River, Hood River; September 20 to 23, Clackamas, Canby; September 21 to 24, Lane, Eugene; September 22 to 24, Columbia, St. Helens; September 24 to 25, Klamath, Klamath Falls; September 23 to 24, Wheeler, Fossil; September 27 to October 2, State Fair, Salem; September 30 to October 2, Harney, Burns; October 4 to 9, Multnomah, Gresham; October 4 to 7, Wasco, The Dalles; October 5 to 8, Linn, Albany; October 6 to 9, Oregon-Interstate, Prineville; October 7 to 9, Polk, Dallas; October 8 to 9, Umatilla, Hermiston; October 12 to 16, Sherman, Moro; November 13 to 20, Pacific International Livestock exposition, Portland.

The extension service has not learned of other fair dates, which it will help make public as rapidly as ascertained.
