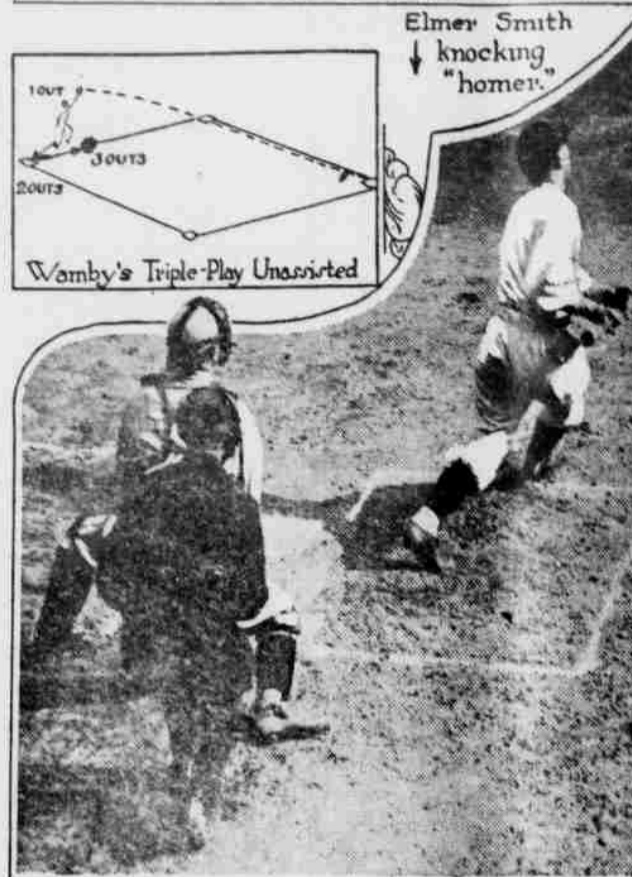

FARM BUREAU OFFICIALS PLAN STATE FEDERATION

Representatives Will Meet in Portland, October 22 to Consider Adoption of Constitution.

Farm bureau officials from all over the state will meet in Portland October 22 and 23, to consider the report of officials appointed to draft a constitution and by-laws for the state farm bureau federation.

The committee appointed to act on the constitution and by-laws consists of George A. Mansfield, Jackson county, chairman; P. O. Powell, Polk; O. R. Dougherty, Clackamas; J. H. Dobbin, Wallowa; Albert Hunter, Union; and W. W. Harrah, Umatilla. These men met at the state fair at Salem and completed a tentative constitution for state

Portland, Ore.—Exports in this city for August reached \$5,642,466 and import were valued at \$525,000, according to government figures just compiled. The port shipped to 23 countries, sending principally wheat, coal, iron and other lumber, iron and steel manufactures, machinery, evaporated milk, paper, railroad ties, canned salmon and flour.

Cottage Grove, Ore.—A large dry shed is being erected by the Western Lumber and Export company at its mill. This shed will care for half a million feet of lumber.

Redmond, Ore.—Crisis potatoes, to be shipped out as seed, are now being harvested on a tract of 300 acres, which last March was covered with sagebrush. The land has been reclaimed by the Deschutes Valley Seed company, now harvesting an excellent crop.
