

Notice of Estimated Expenses and Proposed Tax Levy for Morrow County, Oregon, for the Year 1921.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Thursday, the 2nd day of December, 1920, the County Court of Morrow County, Oregon, will be in regular session at the Court House in Heppner, Oregon, and any taxpayer of Morrow County, Oregon, will be heard in favor or against the proposed tax levy hereinafter proposed:

ITEMIZED STATEMENT

Prepared in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 234 of the 1913 Oregon Session Laws, showing an estimate of the amount of money required to be raised by taxation by Morrow County, Oregon, for the year 1920, and also the estimated amount of the balance in the various office or officer, and for each county improvement and maintenance of public highways, roads and bridges, and for the other contemplated expenditures.

Also showing the probable receipts of Morrow County, Oregon, from sources other than direct taxation upon real and personal property for the year 1921, and also the estimated amount of the balance in the various funds of Morrow County, Oregon, at the date levy will be made.

It is estimated that it will require a levy of 13 Mills to raise the amount shown by the above estimate, after deducting all estimated receipts from other sources than taxation.
