Anchorage, Alaska.—Viewing Alas-
ka from the clouds has become popu-
lar since the introduction of passenger
planes, the first of which made its

is operating from 15 to 20 hours a day
to accommodate the large number of

Kinley from altitudes of from 5000 to
10,000 feet. The peak, about 20,000

Removing Ink Stains.

ately cover these spots with ground-
