Oregon farmers to the number of 10,007 have availed themselves of loans totalling \$30,648,850 from federal land banks, joint stock land banks and federal interme diate credit banks since these agencies were first established by law, according to the Sears Roebuck agriculture foundation. During this period the federal land banks and joint stock land banks had applications for loans totalling \$37,096,589 and of this \$30,568,250 was granted, the loans being safeguarded by, 1,831, 138 acres og land in the state having an appraised valuation on land and buildings of \$81,331,092
