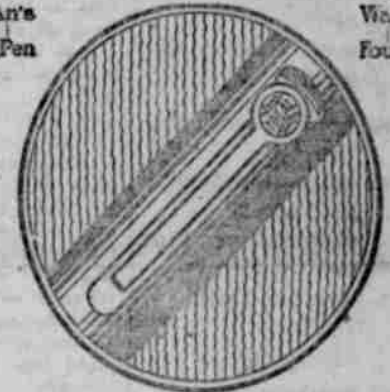

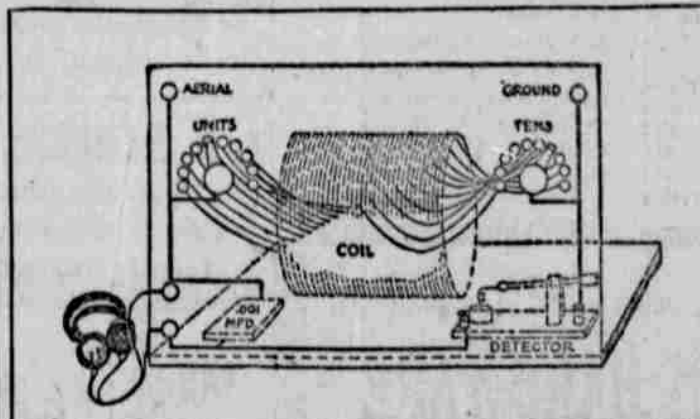


Diagram Showing How to Construct Simple Crystal Set That Gives Results

The receiver about to be described can be constructed with very little expense.

The panel is a piece of half-inch wood, hard rubber or bakelite. The subbase is made of wood. The panel can be any size. We suggest seven inches by nine inches as a convenient one. The subbase is attached to the panel by means of No. 6 wood screws one inch long.

The coil is wound on a cardboard tube four inches in diameter and four inches long. Get one-quarter pound of 22 d. c. e. magnet wire.

### The Winding.

Start the winding and wind on one turn. Make a loop in the wire—a loop about one inch long—then wind on another turn and make another loop the same length. Continue winding on single turns and taking out loops until ten turns have been wound. After this wind on ten turns, make a loop, wind on ten turns more, make another loop, and repeat the process.

Continue until a total of 60 turns have been wound on the tube. Solder leads to the switch points long enough to reach from the left-hand switch to the "units" taps. Also solder leads to switch points of the right-hand switch to reach the "tens" taps. In rotation solder these leads to the ends of the loops, after scraping the insulation from the end of the loop.

### Ready to Tune In.

Connect the aerial to the post on the left and the ground to the post on the right at the top of the panel. Set the fine wire of the detector on the crystal and turn the "tens" switch until a station is heard.

To tune in better after the station is heard turn the "units" switch. This switch gives the necessary fine tuning. The most difficult operation in using this set is to find a sensitive point on the crystal. After this point is found, it is merely necessary to vary the two switches to tune in different stations. —Cleveland News.
