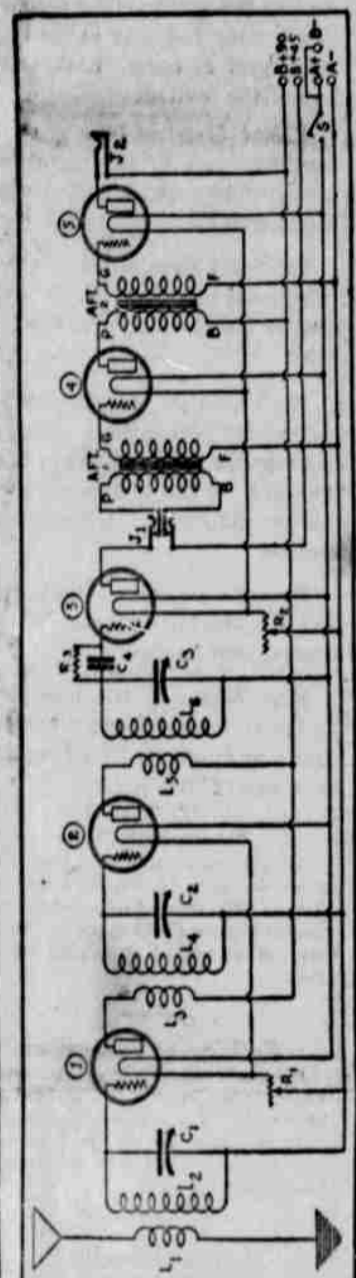

The Tubes.
 The tubes should be 201A, operated from a six-volt storage battery, with 45 volts or less of B battery on the detector plate and 90 on the RF and audio amplifier plates. The set will operate fairly well on dry-cell tubes, such as the 199 type, but the greater volume and amplification from the large tubes make it well worth while to spend the extra amount of money. Except with some types of superheterodynes, the small tubes, or any dry-cell tubes, are not for a perma-



The circuit comprises two stages of tuned radio-frequency amplification, tube detector and two transformer-coupled stages of audio-frequency amplification.
