Have Efficient Ground

and Get Satisfaction

The importance of an efficient ground connection can hardly be over-stated. If there is a resistance to the passage of the high frequency oscillations in any part of the aerial or ground circuit, you find your receiver lacks pep, oscillates badly and runs broadly. Pep or volume, stability and selectivity are three things every fan likes to have in his set, but a large number do not realize what a strong influence a good ground connection has in obtaining results.

It is worth while doing some experimenting with ground connections and you will probably find out some very interesting facts. One of the simplest and best methods to use in testing the efficiency of various ground connections is to tune in a station as far distant as possible, then reduce the volume until you can just hear the signal faintly. Make a note of the dial setting on the rheostat controlling the volume. Now disconnect the ground and try one of the others you have

We threw our hats off in the auto and with shirt collars open sang all the old songs we knew; Marching through Georgia, Red River Valley, etc. We met autos with our hair flying straight back and our bald heads bobbing up and down like a peeled onion in deep water. At Lexington Howard Lane showed us through his fine meat market with tight rooms and pipes covered with frost, fruit, vegetable, and meat; ice cold. He has a fine place.

On our way home we talked about the many changes since we came to the country some 40 years ago, and what changes will take place in the next 40 years.

We were in plane view of Jordan Butte and I told him that there would be a large observatory, a big Church, a good sized store, pastime, large dance hall, big hotel, base ball grounds, pipe line from the Blue Mountains, poplar trees 80 to 100 feet tall, which will look to be 300 feet in height from a distance the pipe line will run on to Ione where it will turn the wheels of an up to date flour mill and will throw its waste waters on the north side country which will blossom like a rose. 1ST AMERICAN YOUTH ENTRY

The American Youth and Teacher Award was established as a tribute to American youth and teachers by the Board of Directors of the Sesqui-Centennial International Exposition, through which the people of the United States and the world at large will celebrate the 150th anniversary of the Declaration of American Independence. The exposition will run from June 1 to December 1. Miss Adams' entry blank cited her for heroism displayed recently when she remained inside a burning building helping doctors render first aid to injured firemen. She is a candidate for the Golden Eagle, the highest gift within the hands of the Girl Scouts. Each state will elect a girl and boy and one teacher to represent them and the successful candidates will be the guest of the Sesqui officials from June 23 to July 5 at the exposition. This will also include a trip to Washington where they will be received by President Coolidge and presented with medals.
