The western municipality has loaned it to the Seaqui-Centennial International Exposition, opening in Philadelphia June 1 and continuing until December 1, to colebrate 150 years of American Independence. At the foot of the sculpture is shown Pompeo Coppini, the sculptor. Dr. Henry Waldo Poe, of Portland, declares the face to be the most correct likeness of Washington ever modeled.
