HEPPNER LOOSES GAME

Third Defeat in last Five Games Played.

Local fans report a real game between a team representing Heppner, consisting of Keough of Los Angeles, Roberts of Portland, Hoskins of Ione, Gentry of Lexington and Van Marter, Finch, Anderson, Hill and Allyn of Heppner. They were opposed by the representatives of Condon, Clow, Fitzmaurice, Brown, Wilkins, the three Ashenfelter brothers, all Condon regulars, and Wheelhouse and Parrish of Arlington and Rietman and Cochran of Ione.

Condon took the eleven inning contest by a score of 3-2, Clow striking out 17 while Keough had 12.

The scoring started by Fitz making a three bagger followed by a grounder which Roberts threw to first allowing the run to come in and ended by Cochran

first up in the eleventh, putting aether roller to Robert which was too slow to allow a put out but a bad throw allowed him to second from where he scored on L. Ashenfelter's hit; Cochran and Rietman taking honors on wining the game; Rietman having made three put outs, three assists, a hit and a sacrifice which scored the first run.

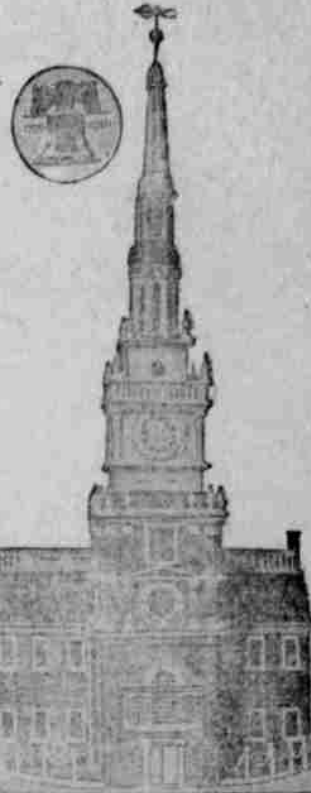
