SUMMONS

IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR MORROW COUNTY.

V. S. Smith, Plaintiff,
vs
O. D. Forbes and Minnie Forbes, his wife, Defendants.

Do O. D. Forbes, Defendant:
IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF OREGON: You are hereby required to appear and answer the complaint filed against you in the above entitled suit on or before January 20th, 1926, being more than six weeks from the date of the first publication of this Summons, and you will take notice that if you fail to so answer or plead within that time for want thereof the plaintiff will apply to the above entitled Court for the relief prayed for in plaintiff's complaint herein, to-wit: For a Decree of this Court, that plaintiff have judgement against the defendants above named for the sum of \$400, with interest thereon at the rate of 8 per cent per annum from March 1st, 1922, the further sum of \$50.00, attorney's fees, and for the redemption and payment of taxes as aforesaid, the sum of \$12.35 with interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum from March 1, 1922, and the further sum of \$61.62, with interest thereon at the rate of 6 per cent per annum from November 4th, 1922, and for plaintiff's costs and disbursements in this suit.

And for a Decree of the above entitled Court, that the plaintiff's mortgage upon the real estate mentioned and described in said Complaint as Lot one (1) Block one (1) in Cliff's second Addition to the Town of Ione Morrow County, Oregon, be foreclosed, and that said real property be sold at foreclosure sale under the order of this Court in the manner provided by law for the sale of property under execution, and that the proceeds from the sale of said real property be applied to the satisfaction of plaintiff's judgement including attorney's fees, payment due on delinquent taxes, costs and disbursements of this suit, and the accruing costs of sale, and the remainder, if any there be, be paid into this Court to be disbursed as the Court is advised and may direct.

For a further Decree that the defendants and all other persons claiming by, through or under them or either of them, be forever barred and foreclosed from all right title interest, lien or claim in, to or upon said real property or any part thereof, save only the statutory right of redemption.

For a further Decree of the Court that the plaintiff may bid at the sale of the said real property and become the purchaser thereof, and that the officer making such sale place purchase thereat, in the immediate possession of said real property and every part thereof.

For a Decree that plaintiff have such other and further relief as to this Court may seem just and equitable.

This Summons is published pursuant to the order of the Hon. Gilbert W. Phelps, Judge of the above entitled Court, duly made and entered on the 13th day of December, 1926, directing that the publication of Summons be made once a week, for a period of six weeks consecutively in the Ione Independent, the first publication therein is made pursuant to said order the 17th day of December, 1926.
