At a regelar meeting of the Common Council of the City of Lone, Dre gem, held on the 2nd day of May, 1927, the Council of said city set the following rates for water to consum

Maimum rate, first 2000 Gals., \$2.00 Each 1990 gallons in excess of 2000 gallons, 30 cents per 1000 gallons.

It was further ordered that consumers be informed, that under section 20, Ordinance No. 63, water cent bedue and payable on the bet day of each month, at the office of the City Marshal, and if payment is not made within tendays thereafter, the water shall be shut off from the premises until payment it made of the amount due together with a 50 cent extra charge against consumer for turning water off and on.
