Notes of Interest to All Local Denominations.

Rev. Livingstone, wife and daughter came up from Hood River Monday and spent the day with Ralph Akers and family.

The grass and weeds around the Christian church were burned Thursday evening, Ralph Akers and Lee Howell officiated.

The Northern Baptist Convention which met in Chicago, May 25 to June 2 passed the following resolutions against lynching: Resolved that recognizing the far reaching injury to foreign mission work resulting from lynching in this supposedly Christian land, the utter inconsistency of this practice with the teachings of Christ, its violation of every ideal of the church and of the foundations of our government, and the duty of the Christian church to do every thing possible to prevent this evil, we would urge to the churches every effort to make this a lynchless land, and would urge pastors and people of support, officers of the law who stand for order and justice to protect prisoners, to take necessary steps against officers who fail to use means in their power to protect prisoners and uphold the law, and to promote legislation for the strengthening of law enforcement.

The National Council of Congregational Churches, in session at Omaha, the same week, adopted similar resolutions as follows: Whereas, in many parts of the country there is an apparent increase in disregard for law and order manifested in criminal acts of recrudescence of lynching, mob outrages and personal violence and Whereas, the churches have a special responsibility in the shaping of public opinion in regard to law enforcement, be it

Resolved that the National Council urge our churches and church members to act wherever and however possible in their respective communities and states to support all public officials in the protection of the lives and property of all citizens, and the securing of speedy justice through process of law.

Rev. C. H. Harrison, Supt. of Congregational Home Missions for Oregon will be in Ione Sunday evening and will preach at the Congregational church.

SMOKER'S FIRES

The number of forest fires caused by the carelessness or thoughtlessness of smokers is increasing, according to the Forest Service. This increase is strikingly shown by 126 such fires in 1922 and 283 smokers' fires in 1926.

Due to the increased use of tobacco, especially of cigarettes, there is a strong tendency to place restrictions on smokers by logging and lumber companies, city fire departments, state legislatures, and the federal government. In the state of California for example, this year all the national forests have been closed to smoking except on improved camp grounds, at places of human habitations, and in certain rocky areas about 7,500 feet in elevation.

Famous Trout Food
