SACCO AND VANZETTI

On April 15, 1920, a paymaster and his guard were robbed and Falls. murdered at a shoe factory in Braintree, Mass. Two Italians, Sac co and Vanzetti we s picioned and arrested. A number of heir their statements made at the time. of their arrest were afterward: proved to be false; other circum stantial evidence pointed to then as themas the perpetrators of th crime. They were tried, found guilty and sentenced to die.

The time that has elapsed since then has been taken up by two motions for a new trial and by pre ceedings in review leading to two decisions of the Supreme Court, which affirmed the procedure of the lower court. The date of the
