the World and the Grand Lodge of Montana, and as our Montana s onger as the years go by," read part of the letter sent to the Grand Lodge of E-gland. Sir Francis Davis, Provincial Grand Master of Worcestershire, representative of the Grand Lodge of Montana near the United Grand dge of England said in answer: "If I may say so, the Montana brethren have been happily in-

spired in choosing cement, as by o doing they symbolize the close brotherhood of Freemasons all over the world and more espeoples.'




