 CALLED BP DEATHPasses Away at His Home Sunday Evening
Johannes Troedson, for 38 years a resident of Morrow Co., died at his home in lone Sunday afternoon. The immediate caus
of his death was an appoplectic atroke but he had been snffering for some time with general debil ity due to old age. The stroke oc. curred in the morning and death followed at about 5:00 o'elock in the afternoon.
Mr. Troedson was born in the town of Skane, Sweden, April 6,
1853. He came to America in

1874 and for some years made his home in Caiifornia.
He was married in San Francisco, January 19, 1884, to Mrs. Christine Carlson. To this union there were burn three children: Anne C., Clara S. und Carl F. He came in October 1889 to Morrow County where he has re sided to the day of his death, Oetwer 23, 1927.
He left to mourn his loss, his wife, one daughter, Anne C.; tw sons; Carl F. Troedson, of lone, and J. A. Carison, of King Citv. Cal, ; one brother, Paul Troedson of Gladstone, 0 ezon.
The funeral service was held from the Congregational church in tone, the Rev. C. G. Blomquist of Portland officiating, and in terment was made in lone ceme tery. Friends and relatives frem far and near filled the church and brought a wealth of floral offerings.
