FAMOUS SIGNATURES IN LODGE'S BIBLE

Seattle, Wash. — An account of a Bible, on the fly leaf of which are the signatures of many famous men, the prized possession of Lafayette Lodge No. 241, is given in the Masonic Tribune.

The most recent of the signatures is that of Col. Charles A. Lindberg, the modern hero of the world. He affixed his signature Sept. 13, 1927, when he visited this city in his famous plane, "The Spirit of St. Louis." Above his writing appears the name of Major F. L. Martin, March 29, 1924, commanding the Navy's round the world air flight expedition, and also those of President Harding, dated July 29, '23, and Marshal Joffre of France, dated April 1, 1922. Above the signature of Joffre is that of Conte de Chambrun, the great, great, great grandson of Marquis de Lafayette for whom the lodge is named. This signature was made Nov. 30, 1921.

SMOKERS CAUSE FIRES

Smokers and campers were again the arch offenders in 1927 in starting man caused forest fires on the 22 additional forests of Oregon and Washington, according to a report just issued by the district forester, Portland, Ore.

Of the total of 405 man caused forest fires covered by the report, 299 or 73 per cent, were caused by smokers and campers.

The grants of the association finance the first year of the students' college work.

The president of a national bank in Fayetteville, Arkansas, has been credited with doing more for the farmers of his section than any other one man. His work has consisted of introducing purebred Hereford cattle into his country, helping employ a county agent, distributing prizes to boys and girls in club work, and distributing better seed.

Preserving Newspapers

The paper upon which modern newspapers are printed becomes brittle when exposed to air for a long time. Some libraries have solved the problem of preserving newspaper files by mounting each sheet between two sheets of thin paper or tissue. This cuts the paper from the air, reducing brittleness but stiffening and strengthening the pages.

Historical Periods

The Jacobean period in Great Britain extended from 1603 to 1625. It may be divided into three phases: From 1603, when James I succeeded the throne, to 1616, when his son Charles I, was beheaded by Cromwell; 1625 to 1649 is the Commonwealth, or Cromwellian period; and from 1649 to 1660, known as the "Brewer King" or "Carolean period."
