WHEAT EXPORTS

Waterborne wheat shipments since March 1st have already exceeded that for the entire month of March, 1927, and the season's total is well above that of last year says a statement from the Traffic Department of the Port of Portland Commission, Portland, Oregon.

During the present month 12 vessels have cleared from Portland carrying 1,180,650 bushels of wheat valued at \$1,525,872, against 810,935 bushels with a value of \$1,065,369, shipped in March, 1927.
