body and prepared it for burial. At the time of his death, Mr. Cochran was 72 years of age. He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. J. H. Cochran, his 4 year old son, Bobby, and two sisters, Mrs. Branner Reese and Mrs. Holmes Holman both resident at Yakima, Wash.

His wife, formerly Ellen Bergstrom, died in 1926.

For the past several years Mr. Cochran has been successfully engaged in farming and had just completed arrangements for harvesting one of the best crops on the north side.

Funeral services were conducted at 10:00 a. m., Friday, June 22nd at the Baptist church in Ione by the B. P. O. E., assisted by Rev. W. W. Head, pastor of the Congregational church, in the presence of a reverent and sympathetic throng that exceeded the capacity of the church. Interment was made in the cemetery at Heppner.
