Art Treasures Found Under Italian Cities

A teamster engaged in carting away earth for a port improvement at Augold coins. Heavy rains in recent nouths brought to light a magnificent Roman mosaic at Girgenti, near Naples. The mosale was originally discovered in 1800, but was covered up

"to avoid spolling the street." It was forgotten until the rain re venled it as a rare and beautifut work of art. It has now been lifted and transported to the archeological museum at Naples. The mosaic consists of a central square 7 feet 7 Inches by 555 feet 10 Inches, decorated with gen metrical designs, rosettes, stars and vividly tinted yellows, reds and blues The mosale weighs four tons and meas ures 200 square feet.
