M. the 15th day of August, 1928, and immediately thereafter the bids received will be publicly opened by the County Court, at the County Court Room in the Court House in Heppner, Oregon, for the purchase of an issue of bonds of Morrow County, for the construction of permanent roads therein in the sum of One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) said bonds to be in denominations of One thousand dollars (\$1,000) each, numbered 1 to 100 inclusive, to bear date of August 1, 1928, and to mature serially in numerical order at the rate of Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) on the first day of August in each of the years 1934 to 1938 inclusive, said bonds to bear interest at the rate of not to exceed five per cent (5 per cent) per annum, payable semi-annually on the first days of February and August, principal and interest payable in United States gold coin at the office of the County Treasurer in Heppner, Oregon, or at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Oregon in New York City.
