NOTICE OF BOND SALE.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the undersigned will receive sealed bids until 2:00 o'clock P. M. the 11th day of August, 1928, and immediately thereafter the bids received will be publicly opened by the County Court, at the County Court Room in the Court House in Heppner, Oregon, for the purchase of an issue of bonds of Morrow County for the construction of permanent roads therein in the sum of One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) said bonds to be in denominations of One thousand dollars (\$1,000) each, numbered 1 to 100 inclusive, to be dated August 1, 1928, and to mature serially in numerical order at the rate of Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) on the first day of August in each of the years 1934 to 1953 inclusive, said bonds to bear interest at the rate of not to exceed five per cent (5 per cent) per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of February and August, principal and interest payable in United States gold coin at the office of the County Treasurer in Heppner, Oregon, or at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Oregon in New York City.

All bonds will be issued bearing the same rate of interest and no bid will be considered which does not conform to this requirement.

All bids must be unconditional and accompanied by a certified check for \$5,000.00.

The Court reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

The approving legal opinion of Messrs. Teal, Winfree, McCulloch and Shuler will be furnished the successful bidder.
