City Hall Notes

from the county in the sum of \$500.00 and an additional amount still to be collected. Councilman Linn suggested that inasmuch as the County had inadvertently withheld moneys due the city, that there should be a rebate of interest on city warrants held by the county. This matter was referred to Councilman Davidson with the request that he bring it before the County Commission ers.

The Committee on Health and Sanitation reported that they had examined certain premises used by W. R. Corley and had found them in good sanitary condition.

The Police Committee to which had been referred the petition of sundry citizens asking for night protective service, reported that after due consideration they were unable to devise any means of granting the prayer of the petitioners but recommended that the Council and Marshal confer with a view to the solution of the problem.

The Mayor called attention to the need of ordinances consistent with the prohibition enforcement and highway traffic statutes of the State of Oregon. The matter was referred to the Recorder, who was directed to secure such ordinances for consideration by the Council.

An ordinance prohibiting the keeping of sheep, goats or hogs in the city of Ione was submitted at this time and by direction of the Mayor the title and text were read by the Recorder. At the close of the reading Mrs. W. R. Corley asked to be heard against the proposed ordinance. Her request was granted and the hearing ended the ordinance was passed to the second and to the third reading.
