Home economics is the one school in which no men major, hence the 96 graduates this year, of which Ethel Linea Troedson is one are all co-eds. Two main curricula are open to students in this school, one leading to commercial pursuits or teaching, and the other to home making and general citizenship. Miss Troedson has had work in household administration, foods and nutrition, home economic education, clothing and textiles, and institutional economics in addition to the liberal studies afforded in other schools of the college.

As 75 per cent of the young women in the United States are married before they are thirty, considerable emphasis is placed on training for the home making career.

Miss Troedson has also been active in campus affairs. She is a member of Kappa Delta, social sorority and the Madrigal Club, women's singing group. She served on the Homecoming committee and has shown an interest in women's athletics, having been on basketball, baseball and class hockey teams. She is also a member of the Women's Athletic Association.

Color of Planets

Venus, Jupiter and Mars are of different colors. Venus is a silvery white, Jupiter is yellowish and Mars is red. The hue of planets represents their true colors, while the color of stars is caused by the temperatures of their surfaces. Observed through a telescope, Venus is seen to be covered with brilliant white clouds, while the clouds of Jupiter are saffron. Mars is not obscured by clouds, however, and through a telescope its surface can be observed. This shows wide expanses of what has been described as red desert, possibly a red sand or rock.
