C. C. Hutchcroft is having some repairing done on his house and is also building some rooms on. John Nash is doing the carpenter work.

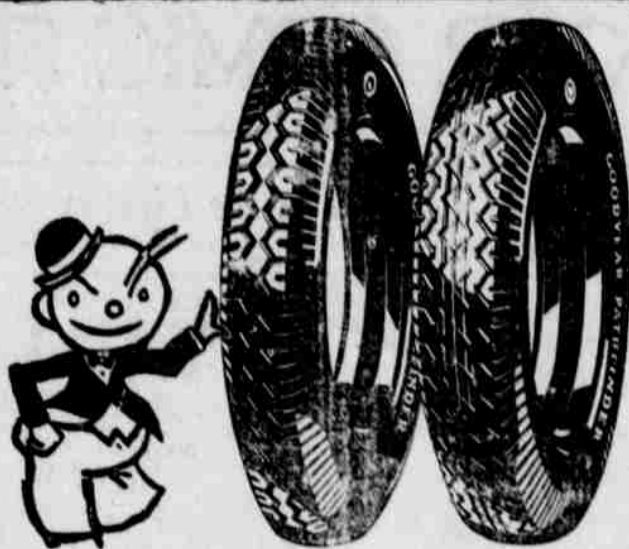
