Its Introduction into Prussia was prohibited by Frederick the Grent A famous Paris physician, Buchot, on the other hand, proclaimed cocon as one of the most noble of discoveries far more worthy to be the food of the gods than nectar and ambreda, and Linnaeus, noted Swedish toranist, who gave cocon its scientific christening coined a name "Theobroma" from two Greek words menning "food for the gods," which remains its scientific name today.

Early Umbrellas Clumsy

The first fashionable sunstades imported into England were inxurious affairs, composed on the outside of bird feathers. During Queen Anne's reign a more practical alled sitk came into use and umbrellas began to be used as much on rainy days as they were under the summer sun.
