NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the undersigned will receive sealed bids until 10 o'clock A. M. the 7th day of May, 1930, and immediately thereafter the bids received will be publicly opened in the County Court, at the County Court Room, in the Court House in Heppner, Oregon, for the purpose of an issue of bonds of Morrow County for the construction of permanent roads therein in the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000), said bonds to be in denominations of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500), each numbered 1 to 100, maturing on June 1, 1930, and to mature semi-annually in equal installments at the rate of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) on the first day of June in each of the years 1930 to 1955, inclusive, said bonds to bear interest at the rate of not to exceed five and one-half per cent (5 1/2%) per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of June and December, principal and interest payable in United States gold coin at the office of the County Treasurer in Heppner, Oregon.

All bids must be unconditional and accompanied by a certified check for \$2,500.00.
