you know it.—Emerson.

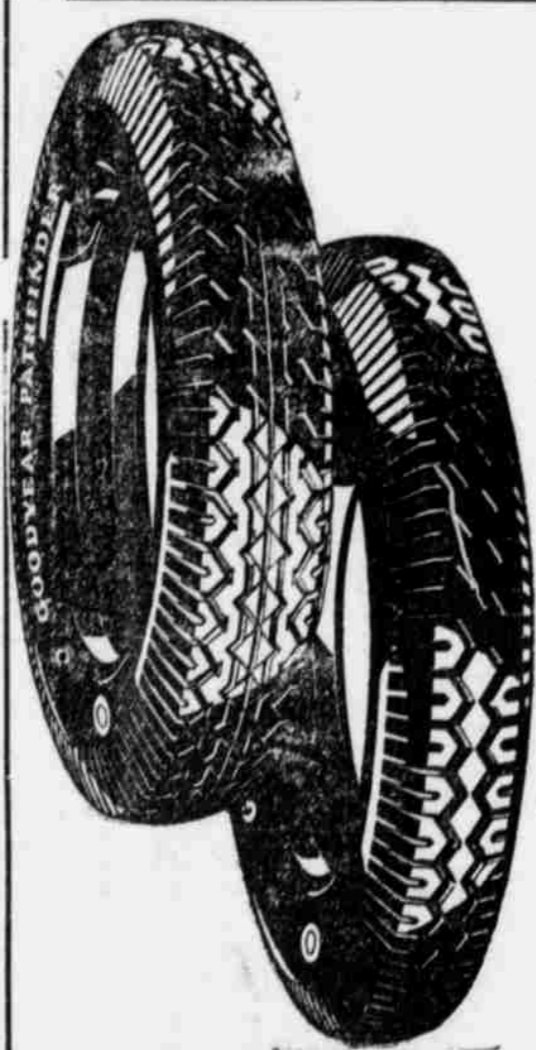
Ancient American City
