### Sinuses

The cells or cavities contained in certain bones, as the frontal, ethmoid, sphenoid and superior maxillary, are called sinuses. The frontal sinuses are two irregular cavities extending upward and outward from their openings on each side of the nasal bridge between the inner and outer layers of the skull, and separated from one another by a thin bony septum. They give rise to the prominence above the root of the nose, called the nasal prominence.

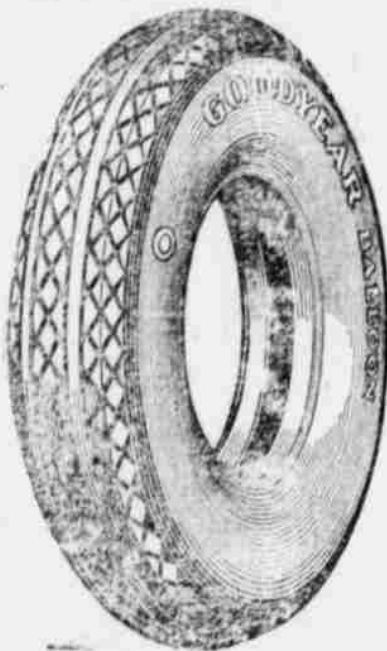
