ton are looking to this state for fine wool breeding stock, thus affording an excellent market for breeding ewes. In Portland the market demands 2500 head of cattle per week which can be supplied by breeders of this state providing their cattle are put on the market regularly in good condition, which is possible.

Steers fattened during the winter months on alfalfa hay make very

profitable gains, the Oregon experiment station finds. Hay-fattened cattle are desirable for beef in the northwest, as in this way they are always ready for the early spring market when prices are the highest.

It is not desirable to fatten steers on grain in the northwest, the Oregon experiment station finds, as they do not bring large enough profits over steers fattened on hay to justify the expense.

This is the time of year to guard

against ewe paralysis, according to the experiment station. This trouble is due primarily to lack of exercise together with too much dry feed. It is avoided by feeding hay at night so the ewe will go into the pasture during the day and get her required exercise. In this way hay supplements the pasture.

The litter in laying houses on successful Oregon poultry farms is changed whenever it becomes damp, whether that is once a week or once every two weeks.
