(From State Board of Health)
Although the popular demand for books on social etiquette is more or less adequately supplied, as yet there exists no manual or handbook on the more important question of the Etiquette of Health.

For instance, among several modes of transmission of human disease, modern sanitation has assigned a high place to personal contact. There are a large number of serious and important diseases, known as contact infections, which are transmitted to a great extent by personal contact.

Personal contacts may be direct or indirect—the more direct the more dangerous. Some contacts depend upon customs difficult to break up, as, for example, indiscriminate kissing and hand shaking. There are a number of contacts, however, which can not be defended on any ground. They simply represent bad health manners.

The essence of good health manners is, after all, consideration for others. This is applicable equally to social or hygienic good form. In this golden age our culture should keep pace with other progress.
