Frank Kilkenny, Jr., was a Heppner and Pendleton visitor Saturday.

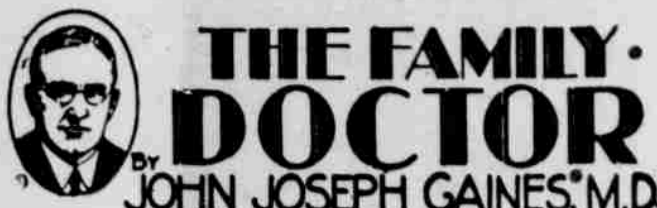
