# Big Increase Foreseen

Corvallis.-Heavy increase in advance registration of graduate students and of students transferring from other institutions is noted in the general increase in applications to attend Oregon State college this fall. While a tendency to get in applications early accounts for some of the indicated increase, a sub-stantial rise in freshman enroll-ment is indicated.

Applications accepted and pend-ing totaled 751 compared with 498 in 1934 on the same August date, an increase of more than 50 per cent, Final freshman registration last year for the first term was 1027, or approximately twice the late August figures. Heaviest increase is noted in schools whose graduates have been in heavy demand for positions lately.

Tentative applications are being received by E. B. Lemon, registrar, for assistance under the National Youth administration employment aid. Application blanks are avail-able on request. Assistance for the same proportion of needy and worthy undergraduate students as was available last year has been assured, giving Oregon State college \$4545 a month to provide supplementary emergency employment for more than 300 students.

#### Poison Barley Gives Results

Gold Beach-Indicative of the effectiveness of the squirrel poison mixed by County Agent R. M. Knox this year is the following story, told to Mr. Knox recently by M. L. De-Martin. Mr. DeMartin took less than a pound of the poison barley with him as he went after the cows one evening and distributed it near the trail as he went. Returning in less than an hour he counted 18 dead squirrels. The next day he took along a box and picked up 40 dead squirrels on top of the ground, while many others had undoubted-ly died in their holes.
