

Two Federal Agency Heads From Oregon

Washington, D. C., Sept. 13—Grants Pass, Oregon, has contributed two governors of the federal Home Loan Bank System. Preston Delano (fifth cousin of the president), was at one time connected with the Grants Pass railroad and was in business in Portland prior to being selected governor of the board. Delano was appointed comptroller of currency, leaving a vacancy which is now filled by James F. Twohy. Prior to and since his connection with the HOLC, Twohy has been interested in endeavoring to extend the Grants Pass railroad to Crescent City, Cal. For years he was president of Twohy Brothers Co., a contracting firm which constructed extensive railroad building in Oregon and Washington and which also built the Grants Pass railroad.

STATE GETS CONTROL FUNDS

Washington, D. C., Sept. 13—Oregon received a share of the \$1,750,000 appropriated for grasshopper control. Enough poison bait was sent to 24 states to fill 185 trains, each train composed of 50 cars. The department of agriculture buys the ingredients and ships them to selected centers where they are mixed and distributed through local agencies to farmers.

NURSERY SCHOOLS APPROVED

Washington, D. C., Sept. 13—President Roosevelt has signed as eligible for WPA funds a state-wide project for Oregon to maintain and operate free nursery schools for the needy. Allotment is estimated at \$91,817 and the sponsor is the state department of education.
