UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, GRAZING SERVICE, Burns, Oregon, September 26, 1939. NOTICE OF ELECTION. As a result of the passage of the act of July 14, 1939 (Pub. No. 173, 76th Cong.), which amends the Taylor Grazing Act by adding section 18, a new section which concerns Advisory Boards, it is necessary to conduct new elections within the various grazing districts.

Elections will be governed by the provisions of the Federal Range Code, revised to August 31, 1938, with section 12, paragraphs a, c, d, and g of the Federal Range Code being amended, September 18, 1939, by the Secretary of the Interior to conform properly with the intent and purpose of the new section (18) of the Taylor Grazing Act.

Election of members of Oregon Grazing District No. 7 Advisory Board will be held in the County Agent's Office, Heppner, Oregon, on October 18.

Five members will be elected: two Sheepmen, two Cattlemen and one Free-use.

Nominations will open at polling place at 1:00 o'clock p. m., and the voting polls will remain open between 2 and 5 o'clock p. m.

Only those persons who are qualified to receive regular, free-use, or non-use licenses or permits will be allowed to vote.
