**APPLICATION FOR JUDGMENT FORECLOSING TAX LIENS**

To each and all of the defendants named in the foregoing Title:

IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF OREGON: You and each of you are hereby notified that pursuant to Chapter 455, Oregon Laws of 1939, the tax collector of Morrow County, Oregon, has duly prepared a list of all real properties within said County and State upon which three years have elapsed from the earliest date of delinquency of taxes levied and charged thereon, and on which two or more annual instalments of delinquent taxes, each such instalment being one-quarter of the earliest date of delinquency, have not been paid, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 5, Oregon Laws of 1935, Special Session, as amended by Chapter 96, Oregon Laws of 1937, and which said taxes are now subject to foreclosure; that such list is known as the "Foreclosure List" and contains the names of the several persons appearing in the latest tax roll as the respective owners of tax-delinquent properties, a description of each property as the same appears in said latest tax roll, the year or years for which taxes are delinquent on each property, together with the amount of delinquent taxes of each year, for the year of 1939 and prior, and the amount of accrued interest thereon to the date of June 15, 1940, at the rate

of 8 per cent per annum; that a copy of said list is hereinafter set forth and included in this summons and notice;

You and each of you are further notified that in the subjoined tabulation of this summons, the left hand column thereof, under the words "Name of Owner as shown by Latest Tax Roll and Description of Property," is the name of the person or persons appearing on the latest tax roll in the hands of the sheriff for collection as owner or owners of the property described under such name or names, and such description shows the description of the several tracts of land herein referred to as the same is described on the tax rolls of Morrow County, Oregon; that in said description, the abbreviation "DR" means Deed Record, and the figures immediately following said abbreviation indicate the book and page of Morrow County Deed Records wherein said tract is described; that the abbreviation (P 423-513) means Probate Journal, pages 423 and 513; that the capital letters "N," "S," "E," and "W" mean respectively North, South, East and West; that the abbreviation "ft." means feet; that the abbreviation "Blk." means Block; that the abbreviation "Inc." included in name of owner means Incorporated, and when included in description of property, means inclusive; that "Heppner Day's," "Heppner Looney's" and "Heppner Mt. Vernon's," mean respectively Day's, Looney's and Mt. Vernon's Addition to the City of Heppner; that "Ione Sperry's 2nd," "Ione Will's" and "Ione Cluff's 7th" mean respectively Sperry's 2nd, Will's, and Cluff's 7th Addition to the City of Ione; following each description in said tabulation and reading from left to right, the column reading "Sec. or Lot" indicates the Section or Lot number; that the column headed "Twp. or Block" indicates Township or Block; that the column headed "Range E. W. M." indicates Range East of the Willamette Meridian that the figures in the column headed "Years of Delinquency" indicate the years for which the tax is delinquent; that the figures in the column headed "Amount of Taxes" indicate the tax due for each year designated on the piece of property described in the first column; that the figures in the column headed "Interest to June 15, 1940" indicate the accrued interest on each year's tax at the rate of eight per cent per annum; that the figures in the column headed "Total" indicate the total of tax and interest to June 15, 1940, for each year on each particular piece of property; that the date and figures on the line with the words "John Day Irrigation" indicate the year, amount of assessment and interest on assessment levied by the John Day Irrigation District; that the following is a true copy of said foreclosure list:

**Non-Resident Cars Off 12 Pct. in State**

For the first seven months of 1940, non-resident motor vehicle registration in Oregon totaled 74,417 vehicles against 84,735 for the same period a year ago, a decrease of 12 percent, it was announced at the secretary of state's office today.

July registration continued to show the decline noted in tourist registration this year, with 27,125 cars this year against 31,721 cars for the corresponding month last year.

Seventy-five percent of the tourist registration in July represented cars from the three western states, Idaho, Washington and California. There were 4 cars from Hawaii, two from Meico, three from the Philippines, two each from Guam and American Samoa and one from Brazil.

Cave City, Ashland and Brookings led the various registration stations in Oregon for the number of out-of-state cars reported for the month, Cave City with 4,995, Ashland with 4,453 and Brookings with 2,814. Following are the registrations from other cities in the state: Umatilla, 1,373; Grants Pass, 1,250; Klamath Falls, 1,029; Gold Beach, 974; Medford, 895; Bend, 897; Arlington, 883; Portland, 823; Astoria, 437; Baker, 343; Eugene, 507; Huntington, 546; La Grande, 388; Marshfield, 362; Ontario, 200; Oregon City, 219; Pendleton, 395; Roseburg, 409.
